

## PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to Section 17-3(b)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes, I, SCOTT T. NAGO, Chief Election Officer of the State of Hawaii do hereby proclaim that a Primary Election will be held on Saturday, August 13, 2016 and a General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of nominating and electing a State Senator to fill a vacant seat, caused by the death of the Honorable Gilbert Kahele, from the Hawaii State Senate, First District, for the unexpired term which ends on November 6, 2018. These elections will be held in conjunction with the regularly scheduled Primary and General Elections on those same dates.

Nomination papers to be signed by not less than fifteen registered voters from the Hawaii State Senate, First District, will be made available, beginning on February 1, 2016, in the Office of Elections and the County of Hawaii Clerk's Office. Candidates to fill the vacant office shall file completed nomination papers not later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 7, 2016 in the Office of Elections or the County of Hawaii Clerk's Office.
