



Hawaii Reapportionment Commission - Redistricting Online

Hawaii Redistricting Online assists the Hawaii Reapportionment Commission, Advisory Councils, advocacy groups, and the public to create state legislative and congressional redistricting plans following the 2020 U.S. Census.

This Click List summarizes the steps shown in the video for managing your redistricting plans.

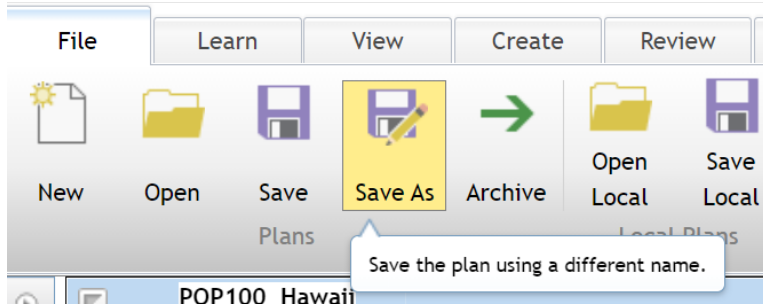
Click List 4 – File tab: Managing Plans

When you first open a template plan you'll see a map and a table of districts and deviations. If you look in the upper right corner above the map, you'll see the name of the plan:



Since this is a template plan it's marked as "(read only)".

To start making your own plan, on the File tab, click "Save As"



Enter a name for your plan and a brief description, then click "OK"

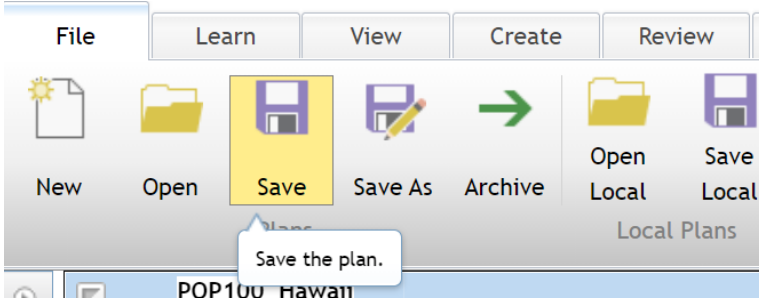
Plan name should be only letters and numbers, spaces and periods are okay, but no other special characters.

You'll see the information in the upper right corner update to show your plan name

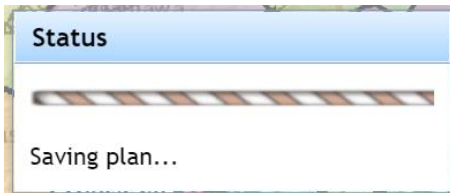

You can now start making changes to your plan, assigning census blocks to districts.

After you've made some changes, it's a good idea to save your work, on the File tab, click "Save"

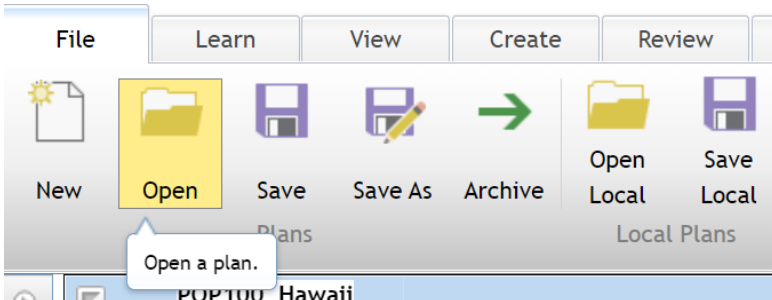


You'll see a message that your changes are being saved



When the window closes your changes have been saved.

You can be working on several different plans. To open one of your plans, on the File tab, click "Open"



In the "Open Plan" window, click "My Plans" in the left column, then click on the plan you want to open (it turns gray) and then click "Open Plan"
