At first, they did not understand what a disability was and why I needed accommodations to get to the front of line. Then, I persisted and explained that the federal law, ADA, requires procedures & policies to be modified for disabled people. I pointed out examples like the airplane priority seating & handicap parking spots. Then, they understood what I was asking for and they let me sit and wait until I could get to the front of the line without standing & waiting for 1 hr.
